Commencement Speaker

Dr. Karen Shelton State Health Commisioner Virginia Department of Health

Dr. Shelton was named state health commissioner effective May 1, 2023 by Governor Glenn Youngkin. Dr. Shelton brings to the position a wealth of experience in public health operations and policy, health care management, and in caring for patients in the public health and private health care sectors.



Dr. Shelton, a board-certified obstetrician and

gynecologist, treated patients in Bristol for nearly 20 years before turning her focus to public health. Dr. Shelton first joined the Virginia Department of Health in 2016 to lead the Mount Rogers Health District, which encompasses six county health departments and two city health departments in Southwestern Virginia. As health district director, she led the health district during the opioid overdose crisis and through the COVID-19 pandemic. During the pandemic, the health district led community testing and vaccination efforts, working closely with community leaders and healthcare providers.

Dr. Shelton's honors include being recognized as 2021 Bristolian of the Year by the Bristol Herald Courier newspaper for her work in managing the response to the pandemic. The United Way of Southwest Virginia also noted her work on the pandemic in awarding her its Woman of Distinction Award in 2022.

She is excited to rejoin the Virginia Department of Health and looks forward to working with agency staff and the Youngkin administration in improving the health of all Virginians, enhancing maternal and children's health, and addressing the dual crises of behavioral health and fentanyl poisoning that affects communities across Virginia.

Dr. Shelton received her undergraduate education at Wake Forest University, and her Doctor of Medicine degree from the University of Virginia School of Medicine. She completed her obstetrics and gynecology residency at Eastern Virginia Medical School. Dr. Shelton is married and has two adult children and enjoys hiking.

About Capstone

The Capstone is a culminating experience option for MPH students where the Capstone brings a public health aspect to their disciplinary work.

For the Capstone, students integrate and apply the skills and competencies they have acquired in the classroom and through their Public Health Practice Experience to a public health problem that approximates a professional practice experience.

Students spend the semester working with their public health faculty advisor to develop their Capstone academic paper and presentation.

The Capstone project allows students to further develop knowledge and skills in foundational public health areas as well as in their chosen MPH concentration.

About the Integrative Learning Experience

The Integrative Learning Experience (ILE) is the culminating experience required to complete the Master of Public Health (MPH) degree. The ILE requires students to synthesize the knowledge and skills acquired through their coursework and practical experiences through a team-based public health professional experience.

Students spend the semester working in a team of MPH students on a project that benefits an external stakeholder organization/agency. Along with their external stakeholder mentor, the team of MPH students is guided by a program faculty mentor and the ILF course instructor.

The ILE places significant emphasis on teamwork, mentorship, and leadership development. ILE projects result in team and individual written products.

The ILE allows students to further develop knowledge and skills in foundational public health areas as well as in their chosen MPH concentration.

Special Recognition

Director's Award

The BSPH Director's Award recipient is determined by the Director of the Undergraduate Public Health program in conjunction with the BSPH faculty to recognize a deserving senior.

BSPH Outstanding Senior Award

The Outstanding Senior Sash is awarded to the Outstanding Undergraduate Senior in the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine. The Outstanding Senior is selected based on their academic achievement, service, leadership, engagement with the University and community. The recipient wears the Outstanding Senior Sash at commencement.

BSPH Ut Prosim Service Awared

The Ut Prosim Service Award recognize students for their service in the BSPH program, the PHS department, the University and community. Recipients wear blue cords at commencement.

Leadership Award

The Leadership Award recognize students for their leadership in the BSPH program, the PHS department, the University and community. Recipients wear blue cords at commencement.

Phi Beta Kappa Mu of Virginia Chapter Inductees

Phi Beta Kappa is the nation's oldest and most widely known honor society. The Virginia Tech Mu of Virginia Chapter invites for induction the most outstanding arts and sciences students.

Phi Kappa Phi- Senior Medallion

The Phi Kappa Phi Medallion is awarded by The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi. The Phi Kappa Phi Medallion is awarded at commencement time to the top graduate from each college who earned the highest grade point average. The recipient wears the Phi Kappa Phi Medallion at commencement.

Special Recognitions

BSPH Peer Mentoring Program

The BSPH Peer Mentoring Program is a student-led program designed to foster the academic, social, and professional growth of public health undergraduate students. Exemplary upper level public health students serve as peer mentors for first-year students. The program Student Coordinator and mentors wear salmon cords at commencement.

BSPH & MPH Student Ambassadors

Student Ambassadors are selected yearly by current students, faculty, staff, and alumni of the Public Health Program. The Student Ambassadors support and represent the program, and serve as a liaison to admitted, current, and prospective students. Student Ambassadors wear salmon cords at commencement.

PHA@VT and UPHA@VT Executive Board

The program's student organization, the Public Health Association at Virginia Tech, PHA@VT at the graduate level and UPHA@VT at the undergraduate level, was formed in accordance with the University motto, *Ut Prosim* (That I May Serve) to teach others, gain experience, and improve public health across campus and the community at large. Graduating PHA@VT and UPHA@VT Executive Board members are recognized for their leadership in the organization. Additionally, graduating members that have met PHA@VT service requirements are recognized by the program for their commitment to service across campus and beyond.

Graduate and Professional Student Senate - MPH Senators

Working to improve campus life, scholarly development, and community for all graduate students at Virginia Tech, the Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS) serves as the liaison between graduate students and University Administration. Each year, MPH students serve as GPSS MPH Senators to represent the MPH student body at the university level and to inform their peers of GPSS proceedings, including legislations and programs.

Delta Omega Delta Mu Chapter Inductees

Delta Omega is the honorary society for studies in public health. Founded in 1924, the Delta Mu Chapter at Virginia Tech was chartered in March 2017.

Membership in Delta Omega honors the dedication of individuals to high quality public health scholarship, as well as to the protection and advancement of the health of all people. Selection is based on academic excellence and demonstrated qualities of leadership in public health for students and faculty, and for alumni, on accomplishments that serve as a model for future graduates. Inductees wear the Delta Omega sash at commencement.

Ryan Aday Memorial Award

Ryan Aday was an excellent and highly motivated student who completed his MS Ed in Health Promotion at Virginia Tech. Shortly after graduation, he was diagnosed with cancer and succumbed to the disease. In his honor, Dr. and Mrs. David Aday created the Ryan Aday Memorial Award. Each spring, the MPH Program selects a graduating student from each concentration that has displayed excellence in academics and public health service as an award recipient.
